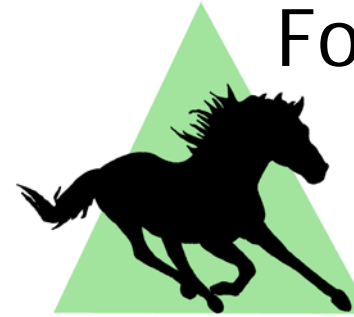


SHOW RULES

1. Forest Edge Arena has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the owners/agents whether written or verbal.
2. Forest Edge Arena shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant has read and understood these terms and conditions and shall indemnify Forest edge Arena or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.
3. No rider under the age of 4 years old permitted.
4. No refunds will be given once classes are entered.
5. All classes to be judged in accordance with Trailblazer Dressage rules
6. Judges decision is final.
7. Hard hats to current BS EN 1384, PAS 015 or ASTM F1163 must be worn & correctly secured whilst mounted.
8. It is recommended that back protectors are worn whilst mounted.
9. All stallions must be kept under control at all times & not handled by anyone under 14 years. All stallions must have red/white/blue ribbon in tail.
10. All droppings to be picked up in the indoor & practice arenas and placed in the wheelbarrow provided.
11. Lorries must not be mucked out onto car park. Please place droppings, hay etc into trailer provided.
12. No bicycles or motorcycles, except disabled scooters, anywhere on site.
13. All dogs must be kept on leads and all dog mess cleaned up.
14. No ball games permitted at any time.
15. No fires or barbeques at any time on the premises.
16. No smoking permitted inside stables, buildings or arena premises.
17. All children under the age of 16 years must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
18. All rubbish/litter to be removed from site or placed in bins provided.
19. Any person who fails to comply with these terms & conditions will be liable to forfeit their fees & expulsion from site.
20. In the event of any rider travelling to a show on their own, details of a contact should be left with the secretary in case of an accident.

TRAILBLAZER RULES

Commanders are permitted at preliminary rounds but not at the National Championship Show

Qualification; will be on class percentage, with all tests at 58% & over gaining qualification at that level, in preliminary rounds. In the event of a partnership ceasing the qualification ceases. Once a competitor has qualified they will be issued with a congratulatory letter telling them they have qualified. The competitor will then have the choice to either take up the qualification or not. Should the competitor decide to accept the qualification for the second rounds, he / she will send the congratulatory letter (within 14 days) together with a cheque for the appropriate fee, made payable to the centre of qualification & with TWO stamped addressed envelopes. One will be used to return a qualification card; the other will be used to send details of the

second rounds. The qualification can be used at any Second Round at the level stated.

Eligibility; Horses that are currently registered with BD or have been within the preceding 12 months with any BD points will not be allowed to compete at Preliminary level, Novice level with more than 60 BD points or Elementary with more than 100 points. Should a horse be downgraded by BD the points awarded will be accepted by Trailblazers.

Seniors; Riding horses/ponies must have attained their 17th birthday on the first day of the National Championship Show.

Juniors; Riding horses/ponies up to 16 years of age and not to have attained their 17th birthday on the first day of the National Championship Show

Dress Code

Hats to be BD standard

Boots Black/Brown long or jodhpur, gaiters or plain half chaps permitted to match jodhpur boots.

Jodhpurs/Breeches Light colour

Jackets Hacking/Navy/Black

Shirts Plain colour with collar, tie or stock as appropriate

Gloves MUST be worn (2 mark penalty if not worn)

Spurs Optional to be metal, worn correctly, not too severe

Whip Optional **Body protector** optional

Tack

Saddle English or Continental

Bits as recognised by British Dressage

Bridle Recognised snaffle only. Double bridle allowed at Elementary

Noseband Obligatory, cavesson, drop or flash permitted with snaffle bridle. A cavesson only with double bridle

Neck strap may be used in preliminary classes & while riding in

Breastplates & Breastgirths permitted

Prohibited tack Cruppers, martingales, bearing/side/running reins, blinkers. Sheepskin seat covers, boots & bandages. No other gadgets or aids permitted
