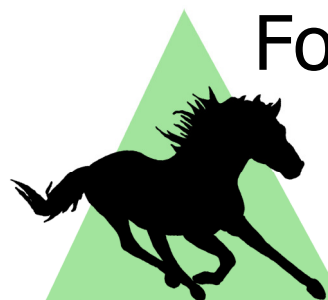


SHOW RULES

1. Forest Edge Arena has taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the owners/agents whether written or verbal.
2. Forest Edge Arena shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant has read and understood these terms and conditions and shall indemnify Forest edge Arena or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.
3. No rider under the age of 4 years old permitted.
4. All entries are on the day & payable at time of booking.
5. No refunds will be given once classes are entered.
6. All classes to be judged in accordance with Trailblazer rules.
7. Judges decision is final.
8. Hard hats to current BS EN 1384, PAS 015 or ASTM F1163 must be worn & correctly secured whilst mounted.
9. It is recommended that back protectors are worn whilst mounted.
10. All stallions must be kept under control at all times & not handled by anyone under 14 years. All stallions must have red/white/blue ribbon in tail.
11. All droppings to be picked up in the indoor & practice arenas and placed in the wheelbarrow provided.
12. Lorries must not be mucked out onto car park. Please place droppings, hay etc into trailer provided.
13. No bicycles or motorcycles, except disabled scooters, anywhere on site.
14. All dogs must be kept on leads and all dog mess cleaned up.
15. No ball games permitted at any time.
16. No fires or barbeques at any time on the premises.
17. No smoking permitted inside stables, buildings or arena premises.
18. All children under the age of 16 years must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
19. All rubbish/litter to be removed from site or placed in bins provided.
20. Any person who fails to comply with these terms & conditions will be liable to forfeit their fees & expulsion from site.
21. In the event of any rider travelling to a show on their own, details of a contact should be left with the secretary in case of an accident.

Trailblazer Rules

1. Juniors riding ponies (148cm & under) must not have attained their 17th Birthday by the first day of the National Championship Show. Except Juniors entering the 65cm 12yrs & under class must not have attained their 13th birthday by the first day of the National Championship Show (in case of dispute, birth certificates may be called for)
2. Junior riders may ride horses over 148cm in senior classes, on or after their 13th birthday.
3. Ponies – NO currently registered JA's will be permitted to compete at the finals.
4. Seniors Classes Open to horses over 148cm. Therefore equines of 148cm are not eligible for this senior competition.
5. Seniors riding equines of 148cm & under are not eligible for qualification to the second rounds.
6. No currently registered Grade A or B horses may compete at the finals. No other restriction on winnings in any class. Riders in the top 150 BSJA (current ranking list) are not eligible.
7. JUMPING RULES TO APPLY e.g. 4 faults for a knockdown, 4 faults for 1st refusal, 8 faults for 2nd refusal, elimination for 3rd refusal. Fall of horse or rider to incur elimination. After a fall the rider must leave the arena on foot.
8. Classes will be run under Table T2 - 2nd round against the clock.
9. Qualifications consist of a double clear in a height class & will entitle that rider / horse / pony combination to compete in any number of qualifying 2nd rounds at that height class.
10. In the event of a partnership ceasing, the qualification ceases.
11. Riders can qualify a horse or pony at any height but can only qualify a maximum of four equines for any one height.
12. Once a competitor has qualified they will be issued with a congratulatory letter telling them they have qualified. The competitor will then have the choice to either take up the qualification or not. Should the competitor decide to accept the qualification for the second rounds, he / she will send the congratulatory letter (within 14 days) together with a cheque for the appropriate fee, made payable to the centre of qualification & with TWO stamped addressed envelopes. One will be used to return a qualification card; the other will be used to send details of the second rounds.
13. Riders can only jump a pony / horse in two Championship classes at the National Championship Show.
14. Hors Concours competitors may elect to go again any number of times but first round of jumping will be the scoring round. They may then compete in the next class as normal.
